HISTORIC TRAIN JOURNEY

Train ride along the Panama Canal @ San Lorenzo

TOUR PACKAGE DESCRIPTION

Experience a historic train passage from Panama City to Colón in the preserved original railway cars. The ride lasts about 1 hour and will take you through the jungles along the Panama Canal.

The railway was finished in 1855. The French association of the Panama Canal acquired the line in 1880 to aid during the construction of the canal. In 1904, the track and canal were bought by Americans and operated until 1979. 1998, the railway was privatized and consequently modernized. Since 2001, the railway is back in use and a one-of-a-kind attraction.

After the train ride, you will leave Colón and head to the port of San Lorenzo. Treasures from Peru were collected and sent en route to Spain in this 15th century port. The complex of ruins is located in the middle of a tropical jungle and encompasses a series of forts, castle buildings, fortifications and walls that surround the bay. After the tour, you will head back to Panama City.
