The Little Corn Island is the smallest one of the Corn Islands of Nicaragua, with a surface of only 3 square meter this islands is a third of the Big Corn Island. It has a long lasting history of being a hangout for pirates for several hundred years. Nowadays the Little Corn Island is known as one of the most beautiful yet little known island in the Caribbean.

Most of the people that visit Big Corn Island also pay a visit to the Little Corn Island. Both islands are unique, however what makes Little Corn even more special is the fact that when compared with Big Corn it is a truly remote paradise. There are no cars, and only a few Hotels & Hostels and electricity is only available during the evenings. All this ensures that tourists will experience the real Caribbean getaway in a very unique way. The Island is completely covered with palm and coconut trees and stunning white sandy beaches where one can relax and enjoy the sun or discover the beautiful underwater world by swimming or diving. Especially the west coast of the island has some of the most beautiful Caribbean beaches. Most popular is the Kelly Gully Bay that consists out of the stunning beaches: Cocal and Iguana. The island is known for its excellent diving facilities.

Large parts of the island are uninhabited and the population of around 900 people is spread around the island. A cluster of restaurants and hotels that is called «The Village» is the main town of the Island. Although there are several restaurants and bars you should visit Big Corn Island if you are looking for extensive nightlife facilities.

How to get there?

You can travel to Little Corn Island by taking a ferry from Big Corn Island. The ferry will bring you to your destination within an hour. Another option is taking a ferry that departs from the Bluefields, a city in Nicaragua. This trip will take 6 hours.



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
